## OBJECTIVES AND INVESTMENT POLICY

The Sub-Fund has been categorized as an ESG Promotion Strategy Sub-Fund has been categorized as an ESS Fromoun Strategy Sub-Fund, as promoting, among other characteristics environmental and social characteristics, which are a binding component, for the assets selection and investment decision-making process, and the companies in which the Sub-Fund shall invest in need to follow good

The Sub-Fund, expressed in Euro, aims to reach a positive return, in absolute terms, through investment in:

a) shares/units of UCITS and/or other undertakings for collective investment, including the Exchange Traded Funds which comply with Environmental, Social and Governance ("ESG") criteria (altogether "the Target Funds"):

c) financial instruments denominated in any currency;

The Management Company's ESG criteria analysis incorporates elements of negative and positive screening alongside general and security specific Socially Responsible Investing ("SRI") / ESG-related analysis and ultimately, in alignment with the investment objective and policy of the sub-fund.

The Sub-Fund may use financial derivative instruments for the purpose of risk hedging and investment purposes. The net direct and indirect exposure to equities instruments will not exceed 60% of the Sub-Fund's net assets. The net direct and indirect exposure to non-investment grade instruments will not exceed 30% of the Sub-Fund's net assets. The Sub-Fund will neither invest directly or indirectly in asset backed securities ("ABS"), mortgage backed securities ("MBS"), nor in contingent convertible securities ("CoCos").

The sub-fund will neither invest directly or indirectly in distressed securities nor in default securities.

Although there are no particular geographic investment limits, the net direct and indirect exposure to instruments issued by entities located in emerging markets will not be more that 30% of the sub-fund's net

assets.

The Target Funds may invest in various asset classes, in accordance with the above limits, which can include without limitation, equity, bond, ETF, TRS, interest rate swaps, credit default swaps, forward foreign exchange, equity futures, bond futures, commodity futures, index futures and options on financial derivative instruments.

The Sub-Fund is actively managed.

This Sub-Fund is not managed in reference to a benchmark. This Sub-Fund has two Unit-Classes: Class R and T. R and T are capitalization Unit-Classes.


